Membership Information

There are four categories of membership:

Professional Practitioner Member
General Member
Student Member, and
Associate Member

Every application for membership requires nomination by an existing Member.

Professional Member:

Professional Membership is available to those who belong to an external registration body - thus having professional negligence insurance plus recognition, and

- have completed a recognized Anthroposophic therapy/medical training; or
- have taken a path of study and personal development in anthroposophic medicine as shown by providing a biography to the Board, and presentation of three (3) case studies, or
- have attended a training which is not "recognized by the medical section", then either the individual and/or the training seeks recognition with the Medical Section, or the individual seeks acknowledgement for professional membership from AAMA.
- each application shall be accompanied by references from two (2) active practitioners in anthroposophic medicine.

General Member: Any allied health or medical practitioner practicing out of anthroposophic principles but does not qualify to be a professional member or is interested in knowing more about anthroposophic medicine.

Student Member: Student membership will be available for those applicants who may be in an Anthroposophic or another medical/allied health practitioner training, or who wishes to support or connect with the work of the AAMA.

Associate Member: Associate membership will be available for those applicants who may be a current **full** or professional member of another Anthroposophic medical /nursing /allied health practitioner association of another country recognised by the Medical Section; or, for those who have been longstanding members of the AAMA or another recognized Anthroposophic medical/nursing/allied health practitioner association recognised by the Medical Section and who are now retired, and who wish to continue to support or connect with the work of the AAMA. This membership shall require no financial contribution to the AAMA. Associate members will have no voting rights.

FEES:

The financial year is from 1st July to 30th June. Members joining between 1st January and 30th June pay half the membership fee.

Professional Member fee \$120

General Member fee \$100

Student Member fee \$35

The AAMA board will have final discretion regarding all membership applications.
